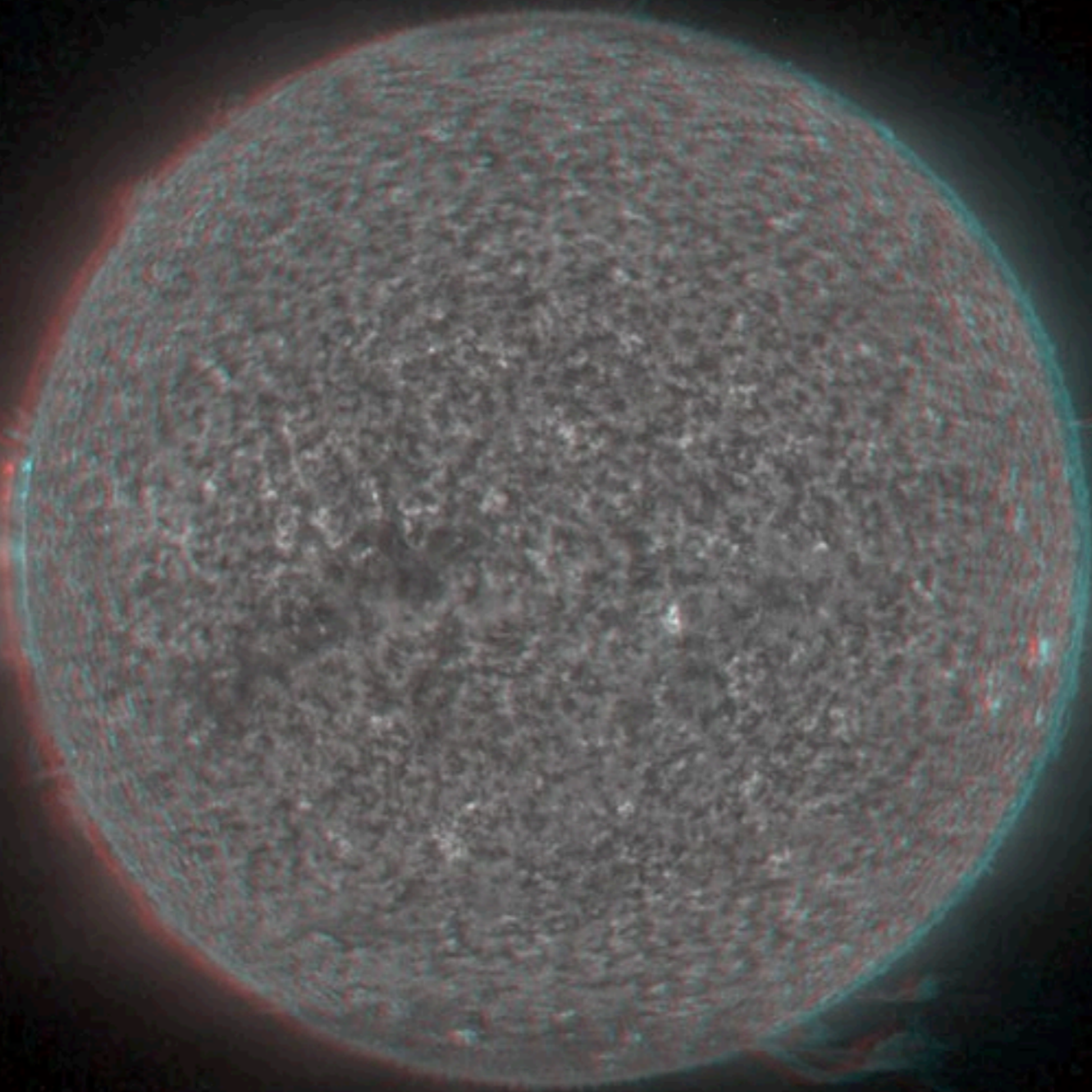






icosahedral geodesic:
