Egg #6	Purple cloth reminds us of how Jesus was mocked. Read John 19:23.
Egg #7	A nail represents those that were used to hang Jesus to the cross.

Egg #8	Dice portray the Roman soldiers gambling for Jesus' robes.

Egg #9	A spear (half toothpick) reminds us of the soldier who pierced Jesus' side.

Egg #10	Gauze depicts how Jesus was wrapped and buried.

Egg #11	The stone shows how they closed the tomb.
