The following persons, having been elected (by the congregation) to the positions of leadership, are asked to come forward as their offices and names are read.

P: In Holy Baptism our Lord Jesus Christ liberated you from sin and death and made you members of his Church. Through Word and Sacrament you have been nurtured in faith. I ask you, together with all who are here gathered, to confess the faith of the Church, the faith in which we are baptized.

P: St. Paul writes: There are different kinds of spiritual gifts, but the same Spirit gives them. There are different ways of serving, but the same Lord is served. P: I now declare you installed as *officers/council members* of this congregation. God bless you with his Holy Spirit, that you may prove faithful servants of Christ.
