The day provides an opportunity to celebrate our global partners in the Meru Diocese, Tanzania, and in the Lutheran Church of El Salvador. The two committees have several suggestions to help you plan a special day for your congregations.

Plan an **intergenerational event** that focuses on learning more about Tanzania and El Salvador. Learn about how the people live, what they eat, their clothing, worship styles and music.

Invite speakers from the partnership committees to share their experience with the people of our partnership countries.

Extend the celebration into worship: include our global partners in your worship prayers, and choose African and Latin American hymns from "With One Voice."

The Meru Partnership committee collects **medical supplies** for the Dispensaries run by the Church. Place a box near the entrance to your worship space labeled "Medicines for Tanzania." El Salvador has recently suffered from devastating earthquakes.
