## Lesson Plan for Joyful Joyful

## Subjects: Children's Bell choir ages 5-9

Goal - To successfully play through Joyful, Joyful one time through with minimal mistakes

**<u>Objective</u>** – To review previous practice and finish learning the chorus.

## Actions:

- 1. Set up music stands with each set of music that has the correct highlighted notes on it
- 2. Line children up in chromatic order of the bells they are playing
- 3. Review the note names as they are written on the staff
- 4. Review the rhythms of each note
- 5. Distribute the appropriate handbells
- 6. Review the proper technique for holding, ringing, and shutting off the bells
- 7. Begin to review the verse section that has previously been taught and practiced
- 8. Introduce the chorus section by reviewing the notes names aurally
- 9. Begin playing the chorus section by pointing to each bell as it is supposed to ring
- 10. Repeat step #9 2 or 3 more times to perfect the chorus section
- 11. Play the chorus section without pointing to each bell
- 12. Play the entire song from the beginning without stopping

## Evaluation:

- 1 Did the students remember the note names from previous lessons?
- 2. Did the students remember the proper techniques for handling the bells at all times?
- 3. Did the students remember correctly the verse section of the music?
- 4. Were the students able to play through the chorus without being pointed at?
- 5 Were the students able to play through the entire song once with minimal mistakes?
