◆ Icebreaker: (10 minutes)

(Have whoever is in the circle introduces themselves: 1. Name 2. Grade 3. Favorite food 4. Something fun they did this Summer.)

◆ Teaching Activity: (20 minutes)

Building your house on unstable ground

First build a house out of cards on the ground. See how high or fancy you can make it.

Tent Pole Leadership

Have each group try to lower the pole down only using to finger to make a plank.

Ask for groups to take turns being the leader.
